**B)-Brushes:** Jerrys Artarama has a line of inexpensive synthetic watercolor brushes called Ebony Splendor Creative Mark. You can purchase a pack of flat brushes and a pack of round brushes which will do nicely.

If you purchase brushes individually you will want:

Flats- 1 inch, ½ inch, ¼, inch

Rounds #2, #4, #8, #10

Filberts #4, #8, #10

#### C-Paper:

**Brands: Fabriano Artistico- Cold Press – 140 lb or / Arches cold press 140 lb paper.** You can buy a watercolor block size 11 x 17 or you can buy two sheets 22 x 30 and cut them into fourths. The paper you paint on is very important so please purchase the brands listed above.

#### **D** Supporting Materials

- **1-**Plastic White Palette: with cover and multiple wells for paints, with center mixing area
  - 2-Support Board: Masonite, foam core, Gatorboard or rigid plexiglass
    - Minimum size 11 x 14 (not needed with paper blocks)
  - 3- Water spray bottle: Any type of plastic bottle that sprays a fine mist,
  - 4\_ Tissues, roll of paper towels,
  - 5- Artist White tape ½ inch, White vinyl eraser, HB or F Pencil, ruler
  - 6 -2 or 3 Plastic Cups or Containers: hold at least 2 cups of water each,
  - 7- small journal and pen: for notes
  - 8) Apron or smock
  - 9) Small portable hair dryer to speed up layering process.
  - 10) Small pad of tracing paper for developing ideas for your compositions

Special Notes\* If you already have Artist grade paints of different colors or sizes of watercolor brushes different than those suggested, bring those to the first class. We will be discussing paints and brushes the first day of class.

\* Please purchase Artist grade paints as Student grade paints have more fillers hence making them opaque which result in muddy color.
